ECOSYSTEMS



AVID strives to protect existing ecosystems, encourage biodiversity, and rehabilitate degraded sites. Waterwise plants are used throughout our landscaping to minimise water-use and create a natural habitat for native wildlife.

- Cooler streets, parks and community areas through healthy trees and plants
- More opportunities to see, hear and enjoy natural fauna and flora
- Enhanced visual appeal of streets and spaces with lush plantings and greener outlooks
- A more tranquil natural environment for greater wellbeing

- Plant local shade tree species in your yard – especially ones that provide food and nectar
- Install nesting boxes to encourage native birds
- Keep an eye out for invasive weeds and be mindful of garden plants that may be toxic or 'escape' and become wild
